4 R Kids Sake is designating the month of August as "Purple Ribbon Month" during their summer campaign to educate and raise awareness of "Kaitlyn's Law" and of the dangers of leaving children unattended in or around motor vehicles.

In memory of Kaitlyn and all of the children who have lost their lives to preventable injuries in and around cars, 4 R Kids Sake will be joined by several fire departments, law enforcement agencies and organizations in recognizing the month of August as "Purple Ribbon" month. Ribbons will be worn on lapels and displayed on car antennas, trees and neighborhood mailboxes throughout cities everywhere serving as gentle reminders that

"Kaitlyn's Law", became effective on January 1, 2002 making it a citable offense to leave a child 6 years of age or younger unattended in a motor vehicle without the supervision of someone at least 12 years of age.
